Dublin Rites In Palestine

Funeral services for O. O. Dublin, 79, of 802 Ash, Palestine, were held Monday, August 6, at 3:00 p.m. in Hassell & Foster Chapel, Palestine, with the Rev. Darwin Scott officiating. Burial was in the Pilgrim Cemetery Elkhart.

Pallbearers were Barry James, Loyd James, Pete Elliott, V. L. Clark, Tom James and Lem Langham.

Mr. Dublin was born December 20, 1893 in Mt. Selman, Texas to the late Mr. and Mrs. A. E. Dublin, and he died Saturday at 9:30 p.m. in a Palestine nursing home following a long illness. Mr. Dublin was a veteran of World War I, having served in France, and during World War II, he was a shipyard employee for Brown & Root. He had lived in Palestine most of his life, and was preceded in death by his wife, Mrs. Stella James Dublin, on April 1, 1973.
