## P.F.C. Allen S. Dunbar

Army PFC Allen S. Dunbar, 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. John B. Dunbar of 107 West 17th Houston, formerly of Crockett, was killed in action in Viet Nam Aug. 29.

PFC Dunbar was born in Houston County, July 27, 1947, and lived in Houston County until 1956, when he moved to Houston with his parents. He was a member of the 14th Baptist Church. He attended Reagan High School before entering the service Dec. 1, 1967. He went to Vict Nam in early May, and was with the 82nd Airborne Division.

Military graveside funeral services were held Saturday at 2 p.m. in the Conner Cemetery, with the Rev. R. J. Rodgers officiating. Military personnel from Fort Hood were pallbearers.
