John E. Easton

Mr. John E. Easton, 73, of Lovelady, died Saturday in a Madisonville hospital of injuries sustained in an automobile accident.

Mr. Easton, a veteran of World War I, was born April 2, 1895, in Eastland County, Captain John, as he was affectionly known to all, was a retired employee of the Texas Department of Corrections, and had served as warden of the Eastham, Blue Ridge and Darrington Prison Farms. He had resided in Lovelady and Houston County since 1934.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Monday in the Callaway Memorial Chapel, with Mr. M. E. Gimon of Lovelady officiating. Burial was in Evergreen Cemetery at Lovelady.

Pallbearers were Cecil Roe, W. T. Bruton, John Paul Stewart, Harold Stone, Atmar Turner and H. T. Deaton.

Survivors include two sons, Foye and Jack Easton, both of Lovelady; a sister, Mrs. Lizzie Steele of Bryan; and three grandchildren.
