Funeral services for Mrs. Mollie Eastwald, 88, were held at Wheeler Funeral Home on May 27 at 10 a.m. Rev. John Cope, pastor of First Christian Church, of which she was a member for many years, officiated at the last rites. Interment was in Garden of Memories in El Campo.
