TRINITY COUNTY – Elliott at age 64 died on Dec. 11, 2006, of lung cancer.

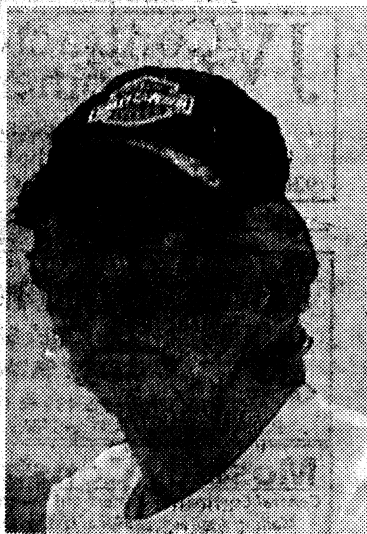
