Mr. Joseph Gerald Ellis, 80, of Crockett, died Tuesday night, April 25, in the Houston County Hospital.

Mr. Ellis was born in Houston County on April 16, 1892, and had lived here for his entire lifetime. A veteran of World War I, he was a member of Brailsford-English Post No. 134, American Legion, of Crockett. He was a member of the Methodist Church.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Friday in the Callaway Memorial chapel, with Rev. H. J. Rhodes and Rev. A. S. Higginbotham officiating. Interment was in Glenwood Cemetery.
