Funeral services for Mr. John William Ellisor, 92, of Toute 1, Greapelnad, were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 25, in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland. Rev. Bland Kerby and Calvin Dickey officiated, and burial was in the Parker Cemetery, west of Grapeland.
