

## Marjorie Nell (Crowder) Emery

HOUSTON — A memorial service for Marjorie Nell (Crowder) Emery, 83, of Houston was held at 3 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 7, 2002, in the Park Place Baptist Church chapel in Houston with Pastor James Clark officiating.

Mrs. Emery died Tuesday, Dec. 3 at her residence in Houston.

Born July 14, 1919, in Houston, she was a 1937 graduate of Charles H. Milby High School. She joined the Park Place Baptist Church in 1929, where she taught Sunday School and helped with the 24-hour prayer line.

She also was, at one time, a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Trinity.
