## W. R. (Bill) English

Services for W. R. (Bill) English, 79, of Lufkin, were held Monday, May 16, in the Gipson Chapel of Lufkin. Rev. Bob Overton officiated and entombment followed in the Garden of Memories Mausoleum.

Mr. English died Sunday in a Lufkin hospital after a brief illness. He was born Sept. 24, 1896, in Houston County and had resided in Lufkin for the past 28 years. He was a retired manager of the Hotel Angelina Barber Shop.

He was a member of the Lufkin local of the Journeyman Barbers Union and a Veteran of World War I. He was a member of the Baptist church.
