McKINNEY -- Memorial services for Dallas L. Ewing, 82, of Carrollton were held at noon Monday, Jan. 27, 2003, in the Turrentine-Jackson-Morrow Chapel in McKinney with the Rev. Danny Buster officiating.

Mr. Ewing died Jan. 24 in Carrollton.

He was born Sept. 10, 1920, in Grand River, Iowa, the son of Mr. and Mrs. James S. Ewing. He was married to Dorothy Getty on Sept. 7, 2002 in Carrollton.
