Mrs. Wilma Sexton Foote, age 92 of Crockett, passed away Friday, January 31, 2003 in the Houston County Nursing Home. Mrs. Foote was born July 5, 1910 in Crockett and was a lifetime resident of Houston County. Mrs. Foote taught music for over 60 years and started playing the organ for Callaway-Allee Funeral Home in 1947.
