John A. Frisby

Funeral services for John A. Frisby, 95, of Rt. 1, Grapeland, were held Friday, Dec 19, at 10 a.m. in Hassell & Foster Chapel, Grapeland, with the Rev. Earl Murdock officiating. Burial was in the Hayes Spring Cemetery, west of Grapeland, under the direction of Hassell & Foster.

Mr. Frisby was born, Sept. 17, 1874 in Bluff City, Arkansas, to the late Elijah Frisby and Mrs. Katherine Woodell Frisby, and he died Wednesday, Dec. 17, at 11:45 p.m. in a Crockett nursing home following a long illness. A retired farmer, he had resided in Houston County most of his life, and was a member of the Assembly of God Church and Woodmen of the World. His wife, Mrs. Mary Katherine Arnold Frisby, died Oct. 13, 1959.

Survivors include a brother, E. Monroe Carson of Grapeland; six grandchildren, John Charles Frisby of Washington, D. C., Lavon Frisby and Mrs. Marie Brown, both of Grapeland, Mrs. Gloria Remon of Alta Loma, Mrs. Laura Averitte of Carrollton, and Mrs. Patsy Harrison of Crockett; 13 great grandchildren.
