Louie A. Frisby

Funeral services for Louie A. Frisby, 65, of Grapeland, were held Friday, Sept. 13, at 3 p.m. in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. Charles Haley and the Rev. J. T. Riley officiating. Burial was in the Evergreen Cemetery, Percilla.

Native and lifelong resident of Grapeland, Mr. Frisby was born Sept. 14, 1902, to John A. Frisby and the late Mrs. Mary Arnold Frisby. He died Thursday, Sept. 12, at 2:30 a.m. in a Grapeland hospital following a short illness. Mr. Frisby was a Baptist, and was the husband of the late Mrs. Minnie Dickey Frisby, who died Oct. 2, 1944.
