TRINITY - Services for George William Frizzell Sr., 75, of Trinity County will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 2, 2006, at the Friendship Harbor Church.

Burial will follow in the Glendale Cemetery.

Family visitation was held at the Friendship Harbor Church at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 1. Friends visitation followed at 7 p.m.

Mr. Frizzell died Sunday, Jan. 29.

Born Aug. 15, 1930, in Houston County, he moved to Harris County in 1945. He served in the military during the Korean War and graduated from Masséy Business College in 1959 with a degree in drafting.

Mr. Frizzell was employed by B&B Wire Co. for 25 years, by McMurray Oil and 2001 Co. for 10 years and retired from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice's Institutional Division in 1996 after 11 years of service.
