Funeral services for Ross Fullerton, 58, of Slocum, were held Saturday, July 4, at 10 a.m. in the Slocum Baptist Church, with Rev. W. C. Littleton and Rev. Joohn Garlington officiating. Burial followed in Strong Memorial park, Slocum.
