Mrs. Janis Marie Baker Ful-  
ton, age 70 of Grapeland,  
passed away Sunday, July 1,  
2007. Mrs. Fulton was born  
September 11, 1936 in Bay  
City to Frank James and Alice  
Callaway Baker. Mrs. Fulton  
graduated from Bay City High  
School in 1955 and entered  
Sam Houston State University  
that fall. Soon after the fall
