Mr. Garrett died Friday, Nov. 12, in a Lufkin hospital.

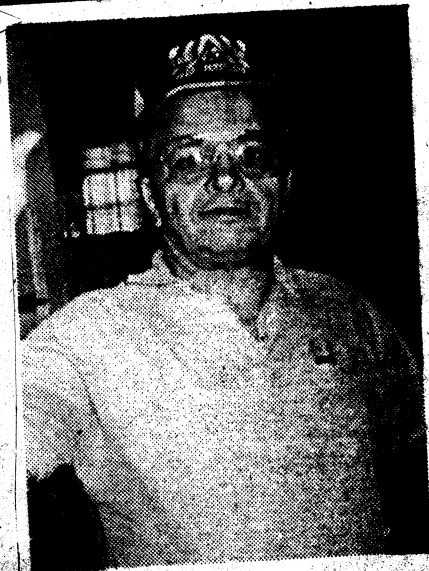
