Funeral services for Mrs. Minnie Garrison, 81, of the Salmon community, Route 2, Elkhart, were held Sunday, February 3, at 2:00 p.m. in the Hassell & Foster Chapel with James Mosley and the Rev. Kenneth Mobley officiating. Burial was in the Guiceland Cemetery.

Lifetime resident of Salmon, Mrs. Garrison was born January 19, 1893 to the late William Trigg and Mrs. Sarah McKinney Trigg, and she died Friday, February 1, at 3:27 a.m. in a Dallas hospital following a brief illness. She was a member of the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, and the widow of Oscar G. Garrison, who preceded her in death on October 12, 1850.
