Mr. Robert Eugene "Bob" Garvey, age 92 of Crockett, passed away Monday, August 5, 2002 at his residence. Mr. Garvey was born December 10, 1909 in Livingston to Eugene Harvey Garvey and Pearl Jones Garvey. Mr. Garvey graduated from Livingston High School in 1929 and attended Texas A&M University class of 1933. After college, he was employed by Shell Oil Company for 41 years where he retired and moved back to Crockett in 1975.
