Norbert F. Gausepohl

TRINITY - Private memorial services for Norbert F. Gausepohl, 86, of Trinity were held at noon Sunday, Aug. 22, 2004, in honor his favorite motion picture, "High Noon."

Mr. Gausepohl died Thursday, Aug. 19, in ETMC-Crockett.

He was born July 27, 1918, in New Baden, Ill., the son of Peter and Theresa Lambert Gausepohl. During World War II her served in the U.S. Army infantry and was awarded two bronze stars and a purple heart.

Mr. Gausepohl was employed as an English professor and was enjoying his retirement, traveling with his son and daughter-in-law until a few weeks ago when he was admitted as a resident of Avalon Place Nursing Home in Trinity.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Evelyn, and a son, Fred Gausepohl.
