Mr. Edwin Alexander Gordon Jr. of Rt. 2, Crockett, died Saturday, Aug 25, in a Crockett nursing home at the age of 76.

Mr. Gordon was born in Falls County, Texas, on June 7, 1897 but had lived in Crockett since 1971. He was a member of the St. Johns Methodist Church of Austin, Texas and was a retired employee of the Texas Liquor Control Board.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Monday, Aug 27, at the Weed-Corley Funeral Home in Austin with burials to follow in the Austin Memorial Gardens.
