GLADEWATER - Graveside services for Virginia Garner Graham, 82, formerly of Trinity, were held Wednesday, April 12, 2006, in the Friendship Cemetery in Gladewater with the Rev. Ted Wlazlowski officiating.

Mrs. Graham died Saturday, April 8, at her home in Lewisville.
