## Frank Pettus Granberry Jr.

Mr. Frank Pettus Granberry Jr., 33, died in a Dallas hospital Monday.

Mr. Granberry, born March 20, 1937, in Houston County, had lived in Dallas the last five years and was employed by the Doubleday Book Store. He was a graduate of Crockett High School and of Baylor University. He was a veteran of five years in the U.S. Marine Corps, and was a member of the first Baptist Church of Crockett.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the First Baptist Church of Crockett, with Rev. E. P. Ramsey and Rev. Max Petty officiating. Burial was in the Grapeland Cemetery.
