Harry Canada Greer

TRINITY — Graveside services for Harry Canada Greer, 25, son of a Trinity County man, were held Friday, March 3, 2006, in the Lyons City Cemetery in Georgia.

Mr. Greer died suddenly on Monday, Feb. 27, at his residence in Athens, Ga.

He was born Dec. 11, 1980, in Houston and was a sixth generation Texan. He resided in Dhahram, Saudi Arabia from an early age until Aug. 13, 1990 when he was evacuated back to the United States at the start of the Persian Gulf War and the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait.

Mr. Greer was known for his talent in the performing arts and had leading roles in plays such as "Cabaret" and "What's Happening Charlie Brown." He also performed classical music on the piano and played both the guitar and dulcimer.

In the past, her worked as a retail clerk at the White Rock Convenience Store on FM 356 near Trinity.

He is preceded in death by two grandparents, Edward Bruce Greer, originally from Pattison, and Hazel Peek Greer of Katy.

Survivors include his father, Harry Lamar Greer of Trinity County; his mother, Kathleen (Kathy) Brasher Coleman of Vidalia, Ga.; a brother, Joseph L. Greer of London, England; a sister, Shannon Greer Cila of Wisconsin; two grandparents, Mose Coleman of Vidalia, Ga., and Ellie Coleman of Florida; an uncle and his spouse, Ed and Vernetta Greer of Glendale; and numerous other uncles, aunts, nephews, nieces and cousins throughout Texas and Georgia.
