## Floyd Winford Griffin

He was born Dec. 20, 1923, in Waco and served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. He resided

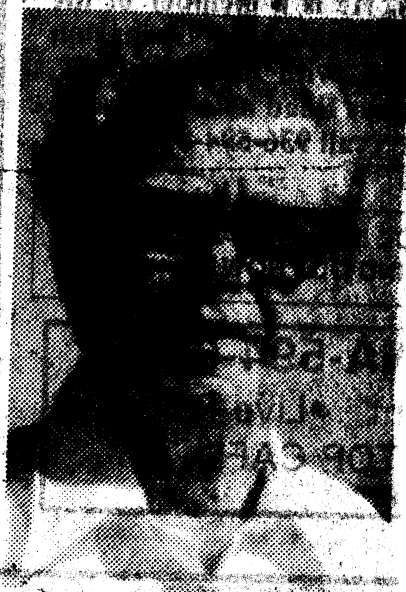
in Waxahachie for 10 years and served as president of the Optimist Club there.
