LIVINGSTON – Funeral services for Tina Louise Griffin, 89, of Houston, formerly of Point Blank, will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 18, 2007, at Eastside Church of God in Christ, Point Blank, with Elder James Elmore officiating.
