Dr. Culver M. Griswold

Dr. Culver M. Griswold, 69, of Crockett, a dermatologist, died Monday in a Houston hospital.

Dr. Griswold, a native of Chillicothe, lived in Houston 30 years before moving to Crockett nine years ago. He was a member of the Methodist church.

Funeral services were held at 3 p.m. Tuesday in St. Luke's Methodist Church of Houston, with Dr. J. Kenneth Shamblin and the Rev. E. Jewel Strong officiating. Entombment was in Forest Park Mausoleum in Houston.

Survivors include the wife, Mrs. Florence Hamilton Griswold of Crockett; a daughter, Mrs. Ed Steadman Jr., of Memphis, Tenn.; two sisters, Mrs. Ovid Hundley of Houston and Mrs. W. Hubert Seale of Abilene; a brother, Jack, of Philadelphia; and three grandchildren.

Dr. Griswold was active in civic work during his residence in Crockett. He was the first president of the Crockett Community Council.
