Howard R. Guice

Funeral services for Howard R. Guice, 83, of Grapeland, were held Wednesday, Oct. 8, at 2 p.m. in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with Rev. Kinnith Mobley officiating. Burial was in the Guiceland Cemetery, Salmon.

Pallbearers were Charles Edward Guice, Jerry Gerhardt, Jim Long, John D. Fussell, Richard N. Fussell, all grandsons, and Harvey Huff.

In addition to all friends of the family, Grady Finch was designated an honorary pallbearer.

Lifelong resident of Houston County, Mr. Guice was born July 28, 1886, to the late Benjamin Randolph Guice and Mrs. Alice Pelham Guice, and he died Monday, Oct. 6, at 10:35 p.m. in a Crockett hospital after a sudden illness. He was a Baptist and a retired mechanic.
