

## John L. Guice

Funeral services for John L. Guice, 83, of Rt. 1, Grapeland, Oak Grove community, were held Thursday, Aug., 20, at 3 p.m. in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. Kennith Mobley and the Rev. Lawson Edge officiating. Burial was in the Guiceland Cemetery, near Grapeland, under the direction of Hassell and Foster.

Mr. Guice was born Aug. 7, 1887 in Grapeland to the late John J. Guice and Mrs. Maggie Florence Campbell Guice, and He died Wednesday morning in a Grapeland hospital following a long illness. A pharmacist, he operated a drug store in Dayton, Texas, a number of years until becoming associated with the Cochran Drug Store in Trinity. He was a member of the Oak Grove Baptist Church.
