Mr. Ed Rhomain Hail, 75, of Rt. 2, Crockett, died Tuesday, April 14, in a local clinic. Mr. Hail, retired from Southwestern Bell Telephone Co., but engaged in farming and ranching, was born June 21, 1894, in Houston County. He was a member of the Christian Church.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Callaway Memorial Chapel, with Mr. T. C. Weston and Mr. Paul Smith officiating. Burial was in Evergreen Memorial park in Crockett.
