Taylor Jonas Hail

Mr. Taylor Jonas Hail, 81, of Rt. 1, Troup, died Friday.

Mr. Hail, a retired jeweler, had lived at Troup for 25 years. He was a descendant of two early Texas families. His paternal grandfather, J. W. Hail, moved to Crockett from Tennessee in 1833 and fought in the battle of San Jacinto. His maternal grandfather, Dr. J. L. Lipscomb, moved to Crockett from Alabama in 1850 and set up medical practice. Mr. Hail attended Crockett public schools and Bradley Tech at Peoria, Ill. He was a memver of the First Baptist Church of Crockett.

Graveside funeral services were held in Glenwood Cemegery in Crockett at 3 p.m. Saturday, with Lynton Smith officiating.

Survivors include a son, James Wilso Hail of Angleton; a daughter, Johnnie Elizabeth English of San Antonio; a sister, Mrs. C. E. McClelland of Tyler; and eight grandchildren. Callaway Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
