Funeral services for Mrs. Cora Ann Ham, of 5202 E. Fifth Katy, Texas, longtime Grapeland resident, were held Friday, March 7, at 3:00 p.m. in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. Kenneth Mobley and the Rev. John Taylor officiating. Burial was in the Grapeland City Cemetery under the direction of Hassell & Foster.
