## Hazel Cornett Ham

TRINITY - Services for Hazel Cornett Ham, 90, of Huntsville and formerly of Trinity were held at 1 p.m. Thursday, July 28, 2005, in the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home in Trinity with Bro. Lyle Stubbs officiating.

Burial followed in the Clapp Cemetery.

Mrs. Ham died Monday, July 25, 2005, at Green Acres Nursing Home in Huntsville.

She was born July 19, 1915, in Hamilton, Ga. and had been a resident of Trinity for about 33 years.

At the age of 20, she was married to Sidney Cornett and together had three children. After 27 years of marriage, Mr. Cornett died in 1964 and she married Jay Ham in 1970. Mr. Ham also preceded her in death in 2004.

Mrs. Ham graduated from high school in 1933 during the Great Depression. She wrote a column for the *Trinity Standard* and was a correspondent for a number of other newspapers during the 1970s.

She was known as a kind person who was always thankful for the little things others did for her.
