

**H.F. "RED" HARWELL**

Mr. H.F. "Red" Harwell, age 80 of Crockett, passed away Sunday, September 25, 2005 in the East Texas Medical Center-Crockett. Mr. Harwell was born April 14, 1925 in Sacramento, California and had lived in Crockett for the past 30 years. Mr. Harwell was a veteran of the U.S. Navy having served during World War II. In 1949 in Whitesboro, Mr. Harwell met his future wife Ruedeën while working as a driller in Sanduesky, the site of the first discovery of oil in North Texas. Starting in 1956 and through 1975 he worked overseas in Venezuela, Columbia, San Salvador and Singapore ending his career as a consultant for Tenneco. Mr. Harwell was a member of the Whitesboro Masonic Lodge #963 and was a member of the Latexo Baptist Church.
