Haselwood

A memorial service for James Smith Haselwood, 66, was held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, October 27, 2007, at St. Luke's Episcopal Church, with the Rev. Dorothy Gremillion officiating.

He was born July 13, 1941 in Tyler, the son of Smith and Adelyn Baxley Haselwood, both of whom preceded him in death.

Mr. Haselwood obtained a bachelor of business administration degree from the University of Miami. He served 15 years as an Alief Fire Department volunteer, three, three years as a Coldspring Fire Department volunteer, five years as an instructor at the Texas A&M Industrial Fire School and was a Texas Society of Fire Service Instructors member. He was certified as a volunteer firefighter by the Texas Volunteer Firefighters and served as training officer in both the Alief and Coldspring fire departments. He was a U.S. Army veteran. Mr. Haselwood spent 12 years sailing the Caribbean in a 40-foot sailboat with his wife.

Mr. Haselwood passed away on Friday, October 19, at his residence in Coldspring. Survivors include his wife, Jeanne Haselwood of Coldspring; daughter, Samantha Haselwood of Cypress; son and daughter-in-law, Jay Smith Haselwood and wife, Dacota, of Seguin; and sister and brother-in-law, Carol and John Risher of The Woodlands.
