## **R.B. Haywood**

**TOMBALL** - Services for R.B. Haywood, 83, of Trinity were held at 11 a.m. Thursday, Nov. 10, 2005, at Klein Funeral Home in Tomball.

Mr. Haywood died Monday, Nov. 7, in Trinity.
