TRINITY — Services for Thomas Alfred Heaton, 88, of Trinity were held at 1 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 26, 2006, at the Waller-Thornton Funeral Home in Trinity with the Rev. Richard Rogers officiating.

Burial followed in the Cedar Grove Cemetery in Trinity.

Mr. Heaton died Wednesday, Aug. 24, at his residence.
