Funeral services for Mrs. Ima Walling Henderson, 75, of Percilla, Rt. 3, Grapeland, were held Thursday, Dec. 11, at 2 p.m. in the Church of Christ, Grapeland, with James Mosley and Gary Montgomery officiating. Burial was in the Parker Cemetery, west of Grapeland, under the direction of Hassell & Foster.

Grandsons served as pallbearers.

Native and lifelong resident of Houston County, Mrs. Henderson was born Dec. 17, 1893 to the late Dave Walling and Mrs. Clarke Ann Baxley Walling, and she died Wednesday, Dec. 10, at 3:15 a.m. in a Jacksonville hospital following an extended illness. She was a member of the Grapeland Church of Christ.

Henderson of Percilla; two sons, Larry Henderson of Jacksonville, and Leroy Cox of Houston; a daughter, Mrs. Guinn Caskey of Ranger; two stepsons, Clay Henderson of Palestine, and Gerald Henderson of Houston; a stepdaughter, Mrs. Clayton Williams of South Houston; a brother, Otto Walling of Grapeland; a sister, Mrs. J. M. Caskey of Amarillo; 14 grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.
