Henderson Rites Held

Funeral services for Leonard C. Henderson, 94, of the Percilla community, Route 3, Grapeland, were held Saturday, August 17, at 2:00 p.m. in the Church of Christ, Grapeland, with James Mosley and Calvin Dickey officiating. Burial was in the Evergreen Cemetery, Percilla, under the direction of Hassell & Foster.

Grandsons served as pallbearers.

Mr. Henderson was born in Delta County, Texas on July 6, 1880, a son of the late Dock, and Callie Henderson, and he died Wednesday, August 14, at 1:00 p.m. in Houston following a sudden illness. A retired farmer, he moved to Percilla in 1919 and was a member of the Church of Christ, Grapeland.
