

Mrs. H. D. (Etta) Hendry

Mrs. H. D. (Etta) Henry, 82, of Star Rt., Crockett, died Monday afternoon in a Crockett hospital, following a short illness.

Mrs. was born in Angelina County on July 1, 1886, but had lived in Houston County, the greater part of her life. She was a member of the Baptist Church.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday in the Ivie Missionary Baptist church, with Rev. Frank Oswald, Baptist minister of Kennard, officiating. Burial was in the Ivie Cemetery.
