Jim William Henry

Mr. Jim William Henry, 37, of Crockett, died Saturday in a local hospital.

Mr. Henry, a former resident of Edinburg, had lived in Houston County the last two years. He was a veteran of World War II.

Funeral services were held at 10 a.m. Monday in the Waller Chapel, with Rev. E. P. Ramsey officiating. Burial was in the Porter Springs Cemetery.
