

Rites Held For 'Penny' Herod

Leland (Penny) Herod

Funeral services for Leland (Penny) Herod, 61, of Grapeland, were held Friday, at 3:00 p.m. in the First Baptist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. Kennit Mobley and the Rev. Billie B. Bonner officiating. Burial was in the Parker Cemetery, west of Grapeland, under the direction of Hassell & Foster.
