Funeral services for Mrs. Leola Herod, 76, of Rt. 2, Grapeland, were held Wednesday, Aug. 16, at 2:30 p.m. in the First Methodist Church of Grapeland, with the Rev. Ben Reily and the Rev. Charles Haley officiating. Burial was in the Parker Cemetery west of Grapeland.

Mrs. Herod, the former Miss Sally Leola Musick, was born in Houston County on June 24, 1891, and died Monday Aug. 14, at 7:10 p.m. in a Palestine hospital.

A life-long resident of Houston County, she was a member of the First Methodist Church of Grapeland, and the Grapeland Good Neighbor Club. Her husband, the late Perry Lee Herod, died Nov 27, 1960
