Mr. Otis Elmo Herod, 76, of Grapeland, died Tuesday, November 7, at 12:15 a.m. in a Crockett nursing home following a long illness.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m. Thursday, Novmeber 9, in the Church of Christ, Grapeland, with James Mosley officiating. Burial will be in the Parker Cemeetery. Remains will be at Hassell & Foster, Grapeland, until carried to the church for services.

Grandsons and nephews will serve as pallbearers.

Mr. Herod was born January 9, 1896 in Grapeland to the late Jim D. Herod and Mattie Lively Herod. Prior to retiring, he operated a grocery store in Grapeland for 20 years, and also engaged in farming. He was a member of the Grapeland Church of Christ, and served in the U. S. Army during World War I.
