Mr. Perry Lee Herod, 72, retired farmer of Grapeland, died Sunday, Nov. 27, at 4:10 p.m. in a Palestine hospital. Native TEXan, Mr. Herod was born Feb. 15, 1888, son of the late Daniel Herod and Virginia Murchison Herod. He was a member of the Woodmen of the World.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Nov. 29, at 10 a.m. in the First Methodist Church, Grapeland, with Rev. John Rozelle and Rev. Bland Kerby officiating. Burial followed in Parker Cemetery, west of Grapeland.
