Boerner Hill

Funeral services for Boerner Hill, 55, of Grapeland, were held Tuesday, at 10 a.m. in the First United Methodist Church, Grapeland, with the Rev. Ben D. Reily officiating. Burial was in the Grapeland City Cemetery.

Members of the Grapeland Masonic Lodge No. 473, of which Mr. Hill was a member, served as pallbearers and had charge at the gravesite.

Lifelong resident of Houston County, Mr. Hill was born in the Daly community near Grapeland on Sept. 28, 1913, to Mrs. Myrtle Gossett Hill and the late Dr. Charles C. Hill, and he died Monday, June 2, at 5 a.m. in a Crockett hospital. An electrician, Mr. Hill was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Grapeland, and during World War II, he served in the Seebees.

Survivors include his mother, Mrs. C. C. Hill, Grapeland; two brothers, Sam Hill and Jim Dan Hill, both of San Antonio; four sisters, Mrs. Travis (Potsy) Moore of Crockett, Mrs. Sam (Addie) Neal of San Leon, Miss Bettye Hill of Grapeland, and Mrs. Charley (Ann) Darsey of Grapeland; several nieces and nephews; two uncles, Mr. Dan Hill of Grapeland, and Mr. Wilson Gossett of Port Arthur; two aunts, Miss May Belle Hill of Dallas, and Mrs. Harry Trube of Crockett.
