Mr. Travis G. Hillis, age 65, of Crockett, passed away Saturday, Sept. 23 at his residence. Mr. Hillis was born Oct. 23, 1934 to Loyce Hillis and Tula May Thompson Hillis in Clinton, Ok at home. The Hillis family moved to Colorado during the Oklahoma dust bowl where he attended school.

Mr. Hillis joined the U.S. Air Force in 1952 serving in the United States and Okinawa, Japan. He was discharged from the Air Force in 1961 then enlisted in the U.S. Army the same year. After serving a tour in Korea and three tours in Vietnam, he retired as CW2 in June 1972.

He worked for 15 years in Houston for Conoco and Power Pak convenience store operations. He moved to Crockett in 1988 and worked for Alsidma until 1997 and was owner and operator of KB Express.
