W. W. (Wilburn) Hodges

Funeral services for Mr. W. W. (Wilburn) Hodges, 59, of 410 West Clark Drive, Corpus Christi, were held Tuesday Oct. 4, at 3:30 p.m. in Hassell and Foster Chapel with Rev. Kenneth Hiner officiating. Burial was in the Denson Springs Cemetery.

Mr. Hodges was born July 11, 1907, and died Sunday, Oct. 2, at 8:15 a.m. in Corpus Christi following a brief illness. He had lived in Corpus for several years, and was an operator of the Celanese Corporation, and a deacon of Forest Park Baptist Church. A veteran of World War II, he was also a member of Palestine Masonic Lodge No. 31.
