### LOUIS EARL HOLLIS

Mr. Louis **Earl** Hollis, age 69, of Crockett, passed away Jan. 19. Mr. Hollis was born Aug. 26, 1929, in Kansas City, Mo. He was a mechanical engineer, working on aircraft and missile design for Boeing and McDonnell-Douglas before retiring and moving to Texas in 1985.

Mr. Hollis was active in Kiwanis and volunteered at Crockett State School, where he had been President of the State Resource Council for the Texas Youth Commission. In 1996, he received the Governor's Award for Volunteer Services. He was a member of the First Baptist Church.

Mr. Hollis was preceded in death by his parents, Louis Eldore Hollis and Florence Hollis, and brother Tommy Hollis.

Survivors include wife Kathy Hollis of Crockett; sons Mike and Scott of Colorado, son Steve of St. Charles, Mo.; daughters Karen Harrison and husband Jack of Marthasville, Mo. and Kristie Brezany and husband Bob of St. Louis, Mo.; aunt Eugenia Houston of Crockett; seven step-children; 25 grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.

At his request, Mr. Hollis' body was donated to Texas A & M medical research.
