Mrs. Charles L. Hooks

Mrs. Charles L. Hooks of Crockett, died Friday in an Alexandria, La., hospital following a brief illness. Mrs. Hooks, 79, was born in Delta County, Texas, on Dec. 1, 1892, and lived there and taught schools for a number of years before moving to Crockett.

Her husband, the late Charles L. Hooks, was city judge of Crockett for many years and preceded her in death in 1969. Mrs. Hooks was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Crockett.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Callaway Memorial Chapel with Rev. H. J. Rhodes officiating. Interment was in Evergreen Memorial Park in Crockett.
